Parcel acreage, enrollment, and contact information can be updated on the Member Portal under "Member Information".

Online Payments

Payment can be submitted online using a debit or credit card by going to "Member Information" and scrolling down to "Billing Information".

Payment to Renew Annual Membership is due before Oct. 31, 2026*



*To ensure uninterrupted enrollment, be aware that a 15% late fee will apply to payments received after Oct. 31, 2026.

What can I expect from Central Valley Regional Water Control Board?

Learn about the different types of notices you may receive from the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, why they are issued, and the steps you should take to remain in compliance.

Regulatory Coverage Requirements

If you own commercially irrigated farmland, you may be required to obtain regulatory coverage under the Irrigated Lands Regulatory Program (ILRP). Most landowners meet this requirement by enrolling with an approved third-party coalition.

Notice of Violation (Failure to Submit INMP Summary Report)

This notice indicates your required Irrigation and Nitrogen Management Plan (INMP) Summary Report was not submitted by the deadline. Submitting the missing report through the Kings River Water Quality Coalition will help bring your operation back into compliance.

Notice of Violation (Non-Enrollment)

This notice means the Central Valley Water Board has determined your irrigated property is not enrolled in the required ILRP. Prompt action is needed to obtain coverage and return to compliance.

Finish this sentence: "Helping our Coalition members means..."

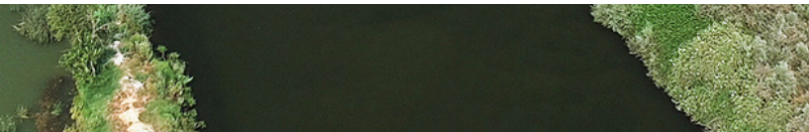
